



Mid Calder Camera Club (MCCC) Studio Sessions Policy

The purpose of the MCCC Studio sessions is to further the skills and knowledge of the MCCC members in the area of Studio Photography. This enables members to experience this aspect of photography first hand and is an ideal learning tool for that purpose.

All attending any Studio Session must be a member and adhere to the policies:

All models to have chaperone with them at all times. All models will sign a release form before starting any Studio Session. In the event that any model is under the age of 16, they must have a guardian present at all times and the guardian will be required to sign the model release form on their behalf.

All MCCC members shall conduct themselves in a professional manner. They will abide by all club rules (including the clubs' Child Protection and Vulnerable Adults Policy, available on the website) during any Studio Session.

No MCCC Member shall have physical contact with any of the models. All directions given by the photographer to the model to show how they want them to pose shall be done verbally or by way of the photographer physically showing the model how they want the model to pose.

Any MCCC Members not adhering to the above policies will be asked to immediately leave the Studio Session and their conduct will be reported to the MCCC Executive Committee for further disciplinary action.
